Meet our keynote: Nanna Bonde Thylstrup



Nanna Bonde Thylstrup is Associate Professor of Modern and Digital Culture at the University of Copenhagen. She is Principal Investigator of the ERC-funded project Data Loss: The Politics of Disappearance, Destruction and Dispossession in Digital Societies (DALOSS), which explores how loss is not merely a technical failure but a constitutive force in digital infrastructures. Her research examines the politics and ethics of data, AI, and digital infrastructures, with a particular focus on archives and knowledge practices in the digital age. She is the author of *The Politics of Mass Digitization* (MIT Press, 2019) and co-editor of *Uncertain Archives: Critical Keywords for the Age of Big Data* (MIT Press, 2021) and *(W)ARCHIVES: Archival Imaginaries, War, and Contemporary Art* (Sternberg Press, 2021). In addition to her academic work, Thylstrup advises cultural heritage institutions and governments on digitization and emerging technologies.
